



## Residential to Beamish for Year 5 pupils – 5 -7 July 2023

*Beamish* is a world-famous open-air museum, telling the story of life in Northeast England during the 1820s, 1900s, 1940s and 1950s.

Located at Beamish, near the town of Stanley, Co Durham, the museum's guiding principle is to preserve an example of everyday life in urban and rural Northeast England at the climax of industrialisation in the early 20th century.

Next year we are inviting our Year 5 pupils to this exciting residential on the 5-7 July 2023.

During the visit the children will be able to take part in various events such as a visit to the museum, guided walks in places not normally seen by the public and campfire activities. They will also be able to take part in workshops such as Evacuees and Victorian lessons.

**The cost of this trip is £105, which will need to be paid on the My Child at School app in full by Friday 23 June 2023.** To secure a place for your child a non-refundable deposit on £20 needs to be paid by **Friday 16 December 2022.** After the initial deposit you have the flexibility to pay weekly or monthly payments until the outstanding balance is paid.
