**Average Scaled Score:**

The lowest scaled score that can be awarded on a KS2 test is 80. The highest scaled score is 120. Pupils scoring at least a scaled score of 100 will have met the expected standard in the test.

**Progress:**

Pupils are placed into Prior Attainment Groups based on the teacher assessments they were awarded at KS1 in reading, writing and maths. These are then compared to pupils' scores in their KS2 SATs Tests and a progress score is given per child. The school's progress score is the average of all its pupils' progress scores.
