Reading Plus helps pupils develop the skills they need to be confident, capable readers.

Families can support their child's reading development while at home by encouraging pupils to access texts based on the reading ability of each individual.



Time Tables Rock Stars is a fun way for children to practise their times tables through engaging games. Children are challenged to answer questions as quick as possible and love to improve their rock star status based on their speed and accuracy.

Pupil Reward Points

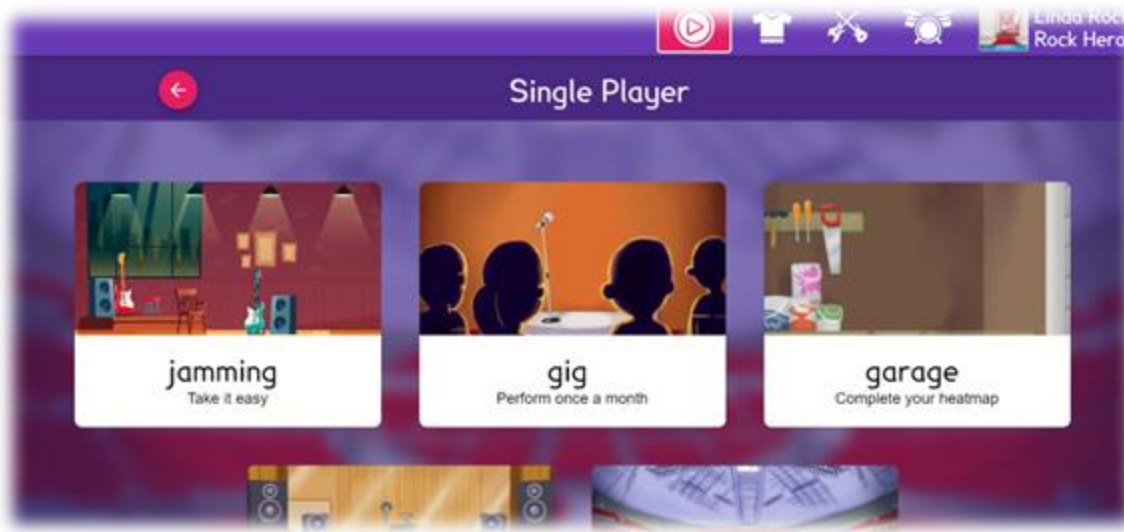

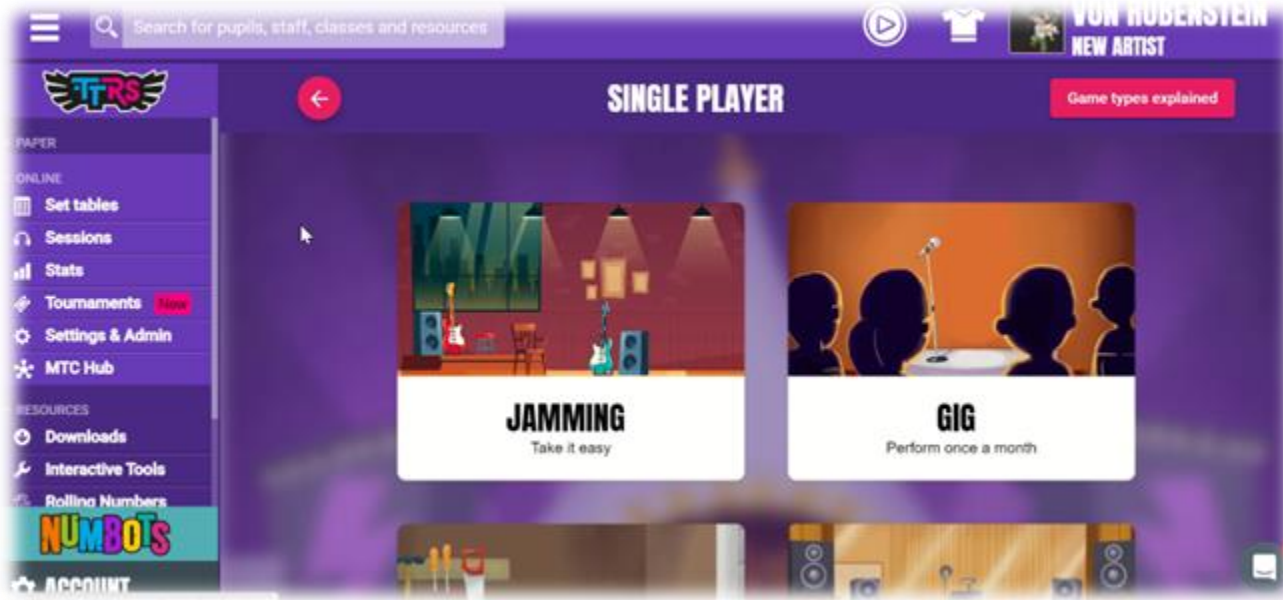

- On Garage you can see your child's gaps.
- The darker the green, the stronger.
- The darker the red, the more practise is needed.
- Hover over and it will tell you how long it is taking your child to answer that question.
- The computer will give questions to your child that are their gaps and will limit green questions shown.

Jamming

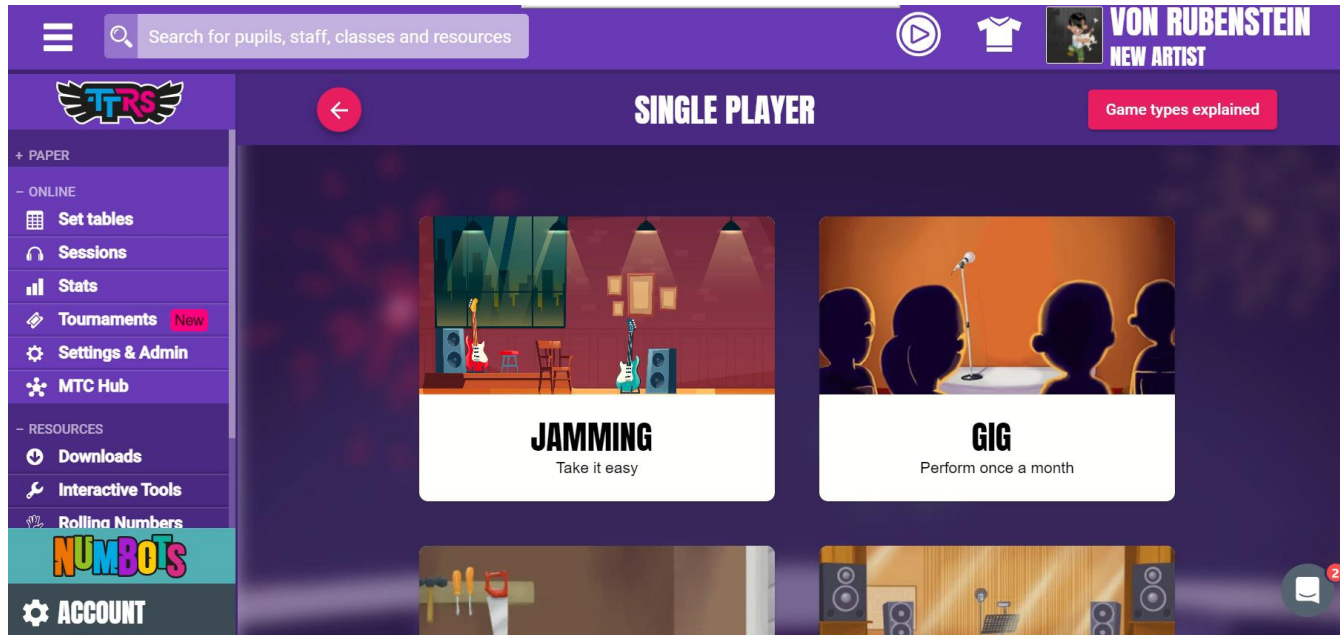


- On Jamming there is no time limit
- You can choose the times tables that you want your child to practise. Base this around their gaps on Garage.
- You can choose multiplication only, division only or both.
- You can decide how many questions you want your child to have.

Studio



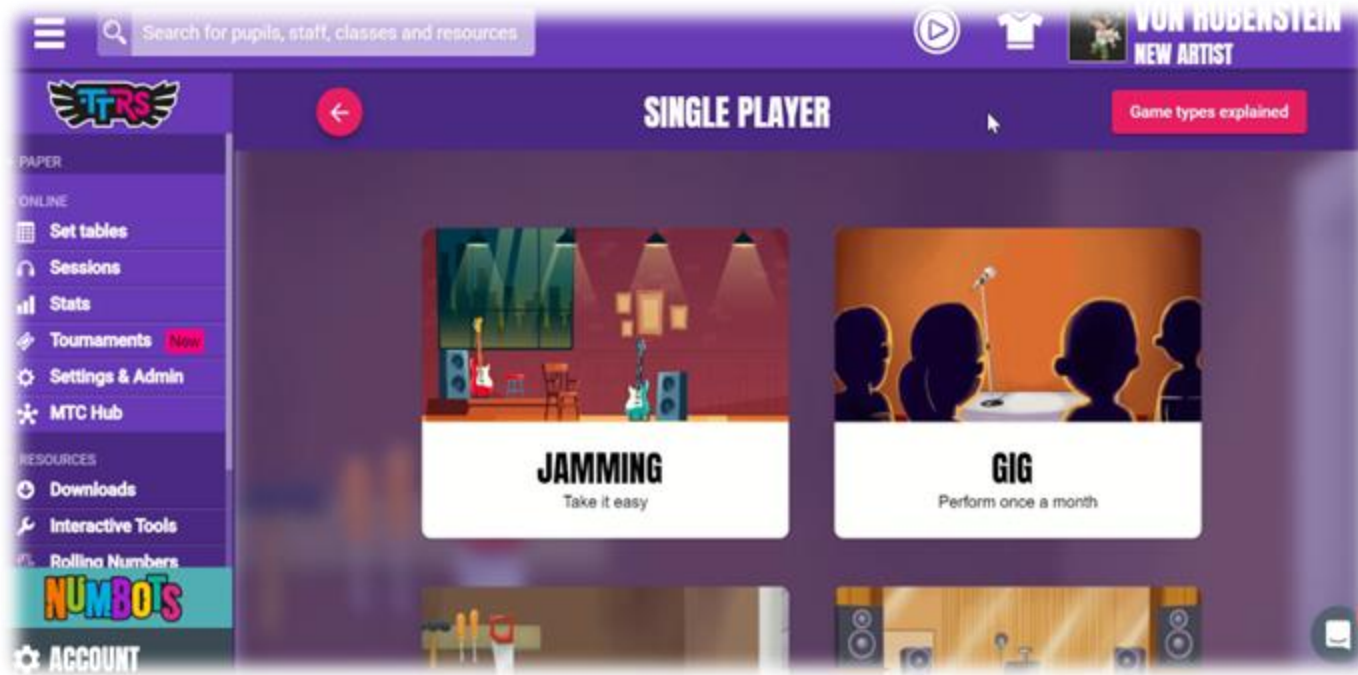
- On Studio, you will be given questions randomly up to 12 x 12.
- You are timed for this.
- Using this game will move you up your rock status. This is based on speed and accuracy.

Times Table Rockstars

Sound Check



The keyboard will only look like this. That is why it is important that times tables are practised this way only.

- By the end of Year 4, all children will sit a statutory times table test called MTC (multiplication times table test).
- The children will answer 25 questions up to 12 x 12.
- They only have 6 seconds to answer each question.
- If they fail to answer the question in time, the next question will appear.
- We train the children to know that they do not get any extra marks for answering in less than 6 seconds.
- Sound Check is TTRS's version of the real test. The only difference is the real one has less colour.

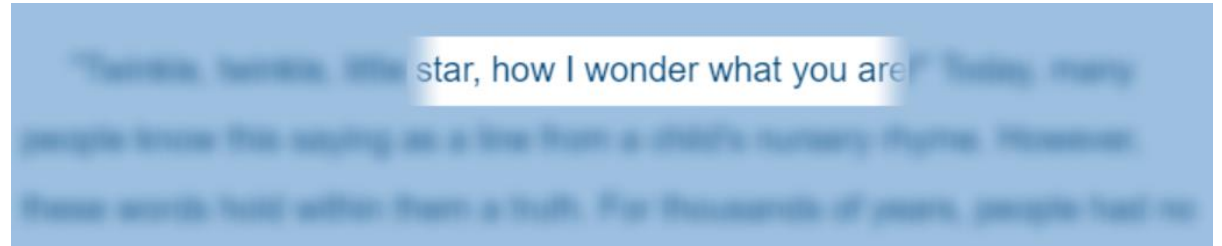

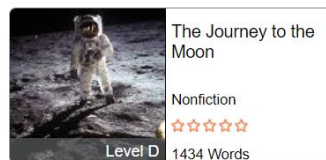
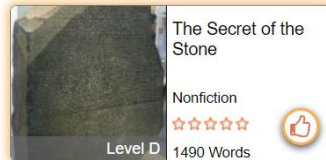
